As at October4, 2013 (2013 AGM)**

1987	Incorporated November 17, 1987
1987	1. The name of the Society is "International Taekwon-Do Federation of B.C."
1987	2. The purposes of the Society are: (a) to assist all branch societies and brnach clubs in the Province of British Columbia with promoting Taekwon-Do, the art and the philosophy throughout British Columbia, and the arranging of tournaments, demonstrations and competitions throughout the Province of British Columbia;
1987	(b) to co-operate with all levels of Government and private enterprise to promote Taekwon-Do in the Province of British Columbia by way of competitions, reports, press releases and advertisement;
1993	3. The International Taekwon-Do Federation of B.C. will regulate and promote Taekwon-Do in British Columbia in accordance with the Constitution and the Bylaws of the International Taekwon-Do Federation (I.T.F.) <u>THIS PARAGRAPH AS PRESENTED SHALL BE AND REMAIN SUBSTANTIALLY A PERMANENT AND UNALTERABLE PART OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE SOCIETY.</u>
1993	4. The International Taekwon-Do Federation of B.C. will be a Certified affiliate of the Canadian Taekwon-Do Federation, International (CTFI) which is a non-profit organization for the promotion of Taekwon-Do in Canada; and by being a certified affiliate of the CTFI to comply with the Constitution and the Bylaws of the Canadian Taekwon-Do Federation, International. If and when there is a conflict between the Constitution and Bylaws of the International Taekwon-Do Federation and the Canadian Taekwon-Do Federation, Internationalthe Constitution and Bylaws of the International Taekwon-Do Federation will prevail. <u>THIS PARAGRAPH AS PRESENTED SHALL BE AND REMAIN SUBSTANTIALLY A PERMANENT AND UNALTERABLE PART OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE SOCIETY.</u>
